Further, the Dean of Students will work with the Head of School to oversee academics and student life, develop programming to address students' social/emotional needs, and serve as lead with admissions.

**Housing is included as part of the compensation for this position. There is a seasonal swimming pool, a hot tub, a greenhouse, and a garden on campus.

Heron School seeks to combine the characteristics of Hogwarts, Xavier's School for Gifted Youngsters, and summer camp. Heron School offers individualized, project-based curriculum developed around students' strengths and interests and driven by instructional scaffolding to connect students with college-level coursework opportunities and guide students to be ready for independent college living. Heron School students struggle in the public school system setting socially, emotionally, and academically due to their unique gifts and intellectual disabilities, which is why Heron School connects students with one-on-one instruction, a smaller class size, project-based curriculum, and an educational setting with minimal external stimulation.
